



Asbestos Awareness Training

The course is of half day's duration and outlines the hazards of asbestos, its various uses in construction and what can or can't be done with asbestos containing materials. The course is based on the requirements of the Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012, Regulation 10, requiring employers to provide training to employees likely to be exposed to asbestos. The course is suitable for personnel who are responsible for managing premises including controlling construction and maintenance projects and also site operatives who may occasionally come into contact with asbestos containing materials. The purpose of the course being to provide delegates with a basic awareness of the hazards associated with asbestos, its likely location and uses and the effect on health from exposure. Operatives who regularly work with asbestos containing materials, e.g. demolition contractors, may require additional training.
