



PA13 – Sub Surface Liquid Applicator

Course Description

This course prepares the trainee to take the City and Guilds NPTC PA13 practical assessment, which combined with a PA1 unit qualifies the operator in the legislative qualification Certificate of Competence in the Safe Use of Pesticides.

Content - the course covers

- Legislation
- Environmental Safety
- Label information
- Nozzles and spray quality
- Types of nozzles
- Preparation of machine for use
- Mixing and filling of the machine
- Calibration
- Site work
- Cleaning and decontamination of the applicator
- Maintenance and storage
- Pesticide application records

Venue

The training takes place on a farm by arrangement.

Duration

One Day - Classroom & Practical
9.00am - 4.30pm approx.

Equipment required

Trainees to bring Wellington boots and suitable personal protective clothing (PPE). The venue will provide the necessary machinery for the training.

Pre-requisites

PA1 Safe Use of Pesticide
