Course Description

This module is intended to accommodate any item of pesticide application equipment for which there is no category in the existing suite of schedules (PA2 – PA13).

- Preparation of equipment for use
- Mixing and filling of the equipment
- Calibration
- Site work
- · Cleaning and decontamination of the applicator
- Maintenance and storage
- Pesticide application records

Venue

The training takes place at your place of work by arrangement.

Duration

One Day - Classroom & Practical 9.00am - 4.30pm approx.

Equipment required

Trainees to bring Wellington boots and suitable personal protective clothing (PPE). The venue will provide the necessary machinery for the training. Typical examples of equipment which would qualify for a PA(SC) assessment would be:

- Automated glasshouse sprayers
- Multi-modal applicators on potato planters
- Rail-track bankside spraying modules
